On Tuesday October 11th 2022, Brian Keith Nichols, (32) went to be with the Lord.

Brian was the father of two boys, Braydon Sawyer Nichols (10) and Bryson Kaydon Nichols (9)

Brian is preceded in death by his older brother Eric Nichols, father Aubrey Nichols, and step father, Gary Smith.

Brian was born in Tuscaloosa Alabama at DCH. He grew up in the small town of West Blocton

Alabama, later moving to the McCalla/Brookwood area with his mother and stepfather. Brian

played highschool football for many of his highschool years, and his senior year decided he

wanted to start his career early with engineer training in the Army, under the National Guard and

took his GED, passing with flying colors, to enlist in the in 2008.

In 2010 he unfortunately had a terrible accident falling 3 stories and injuring his hip, legs, and

arm, which unfortunately led to being medically/honorably discharged from the Army. He began

working odd jobs and later reunited with his high school sweetheart, Meghan, to whom he

married in 2011 and the following year they brought their first son into the world, Braydon

Nichols. The following year they welcomed their son, Bryson Nichols

Brian dealt with many struggles in his life after his accident. But he was very optimistic in life and

still a dreamer and extremely innovative. He loved to make others laugh. He had a very witty

sense of humor and most responses were silly and sarcastic. He prided himself on his biblical

knowledge and ability to quote scripture.

Brian loved fishing and often was called Spinner Bait. He also enjoyed watching Alabama

football. In his last days he spent his time with his boys who he adored, riding bikes, watching

movies, and enjoying spending time with one another.

Brian is survived by his mother; Glenda Smith, his sons; Braydon and Bryson Nichols, brother;

Aubrey Nichols Jr, sister; Jennifer Nichols (Kevin), sister; Cindi Taylor (Jerry), grandmother;
