Charles Ray "Charlie" Tucker, age 89 of Hueytown passed away on Friday, March 28, 2014 at his home. Mr. Tucker was a graduate of Hueytown High School in 1943; WWII Veteran who served in the Navy and became a Corpsman in the U.S. Marine Corp. from 1943 to 1946; he was a member of the Bethlehem Methodist Church in Hueytown for 78 years and taught Sunday school for over 50 years. He was inducted into the Alabama Softball Hall of Fame on August 19, 2006.
