Donald W. Hogue, Sr., age 86, of Montevallo, AL, passed away Tuesday, June 12, 2012. Mr. Hogue served with the U.S. Army from November 1943 until December 1945. He was a World War II veteran and a participant of the Battle of the Bulge. He received the World War II Victory Medal, the European African Middle Eastern Service Medal with one Bronze Star and one Silver Star, the Croix DeGuerre (French Citation) and a Purple Heart. He was also a member of the Masonic Lodge #170 in Montevallo. He was preceded in death by his wife, Margaret Hogue; his parents, James S. and Beulah Hyce Hogue. He is survived by his son, Donnie (Vicki) Hogue; his daughters, Gloria (Orville) Canoles, Betty (Ray) Shirley, Debra (Kevin) Berland and Nancy Northcutt; eleven grandchildren, sixteen great grandchildren, one great great grandchild; his brothers, James Hogue and Horace (Hallie) Hogue.
