



## Edgar B. "Bo" Speer, IV

Bo Speer, age 31 of Homewood, AL, went to be with the Lord on Sunday, November 9, 2014. He was a 2001 graduate of Homewood High School. While there he enjoyed playing sports; he was on the 2000 State Championship Football Team and the 2001 State Championship Wrestling Team. He delayed entering Auburn University in order to enter the United States Marine Corp. He served in the 414 Marine Corp Unit and fought for his country in the Iraq War. After returning from war, Bo returned to Auburn University, where he was an officer and a proud member of the Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity. He graduated from Auburn in 2007. He was currently employed by Yates Construction Company. He is survived by his parents, Edgar B. "Ned" and Sharlene Speer; his sister, Stephanie (Tommy) Horton; and his brother, Springer Speer. A memorial service will be held on Thursday, November 13, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at Dawson Baptist Church, 1114 Oxmoor Road, Homewood, AL 35209. 
