



## Jetty Helen Sullivan

January 6, 1937 - January 19, 2021

On January 19, 2021, Jetty Helen Sullivan passed away in her sleep at the Colonel Robert L. Howard Veterans Nursing Home in Pell City, Alabama. Born on January 6, 1937 in the old mining town of Praco, Alabama that is now called West Jefferson, Jetty was the youngest of 9 children born to Fred and Jennie Sullivan.

Jetty graduated from Hueytown High School in 1955. She received her degree in nursing at the Birmingham Southern College School of Nursing, graduating in 1958. She had a sense of independence and adventure and joined the Air Force as a Registered Nurse and logged at least one year of foreign service. Jetty was honorably discharged in June of 1968 with the rank of Captain. She retired from nursing in 2001 after 43 years.

Jetty is the last of her nine siblings to pass and is preceded in death by her mother and father, Jennie Short Sullivan and Fred Sullivan and her brothers and sisters, Braxton Sullivan, Hansel Sullivan, Elouise Bailey, Early Sullivan, Evelyne Sullivan Pridemore, Curtis Sullivan, Johnny Sullivan and Clarence Sullivan.
