Lois Virginia Kelso Brockman, age 90, originally from Fairfield, AL, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Saturday, May 23, 2020 (as a result of so many illnesses and complications it was a miracle she didn't succumb while going about her daily activities). Lois was born in Fairfield, and lived there most of her life. She graduated from Fairfield High School in 1947. After high school, Lois attended the University of Montevallo, and Auburn University briefly, until Roy drove to campus, took her home and married her.
