Margaret Louise Thomason Hickey, 82, of Bessemer, Alabama died on Tuesday, July 16, 2024. Ms. Hickey was born on September 3, 1941. She trained at Carraway Hospital as an Inhalation Therapist and worked at Lloyd Noland Hospital for over 33 years in Respiratory Therapy and as a Certified Respiratory Technician administering breathing tests for Black Lung and other related diseases. She was a volunteer at UAB Medical West. She is predeceased by her father, Clyde Y. Thomason, of Quitman, Arkansas; her mother, Mary Red, of Little Rock, Arkansas; her sister, Ouida Adele Thomason Edwards, of Harrison, Arkansas. She is survived by her son, James T.
