Nancy Jo Collier, 66, passed away Friday, January 28th at UAB Medical West. Jo is preceded in death by her husband, Willie Collier and her mother, Nonnie Horton. Jo was saved at Mount Carmel Baptist Church in West Blocton where she attended with her family. She became involved with Christian Endeavors (CE) where she attended camp while a teenager and later as an adult leader. After marriage she joined her husband at Tannehill Valley Baptist Church where she was a member for over 30 years. She taught children in Sunday school and VBS, went on annual mission trips with her husband, faithfully attended a prayer circle and enjoyed a weekly crafter's class. Although Jo had no children of her own she 'mothered' children throughout her life. She loved her family unconditionally and was always giving gifts, sending cards and making 'birthday phone calls'. She trusted God completely in every aspect of her life. During her later years she developed Parkinson and diabetes which caused tremendous physical limitations, yet she never wavered in her attendance to her church. She enjoyed the simple things in life; crafts, puzzles, trips to Montreat, NC, Alabama football, visiting her dad 3 days a week, sending Christmas, valentine and birthday cards and raiding thrift stores with her best friend and sister-in-law, Bit. Everybody loved Jo! She will be sorely missed.
