Paul Jeffery Rohrbach was born in Bessemer, Alabama on October 29, 1957 and passed away on Sunday, February 9 while fishing in the Cahaba River near Birmingham. He is survived by his wife Beth and two sons, Dylan and Ryder, of Hoover and his parents Ed and Jeanette Rohrbach of Bessemer, AL. Paul was married to Beth for 20 years. He also is survived by three siblings: Ed Rohrbach, Jr. (Karen) of McCalla, AL; Cathy Graves (Larry) of Bessemer, AL; and Tim Rohrbach (DeAnn) of Helena, AL. His extended family also includes two fathers-in-law, William L. Polhemus and Luis M. Pagan, mother-in-law Elaine Pagan and several nieces, nephews, extended loving family and friends. Paul was a beloved husband, father, son, brother, uncle and friend. He was active with the Boy Scouts of America. Paul was a graduate of McAdory High School, Herzing Institute and the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Paul worked for more than 19 years in IT/Information Systems with Raycom Media and the Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail. He helped create golf events to benefit Alabama charities and was well known by professional golfers competing along the RTJ Golf Trail. However, he would want to be remembered for his love of his family and the outdoors. Paul stated, "I am totally not what I do. I am an outdoor guy. I have a gypsy spirit and love to travel around to any place I haven't been before. I'll climb, hike, bike, swim or eat anything, or at least try. I keep a map of Alabama with me and I mark all the roads I have traveled. There is so much to see and do rather than just waiting. Why did Paulie take that road? To see what was at

the other end.” Paul has gone on to explore another path and will be greatly missed by his family and friends.
