Dr. Percy G. Sullivan, 89, of Bessemer, AL passed away Tuesday, October 18, 2016. He was a member of Shepherd of the Valley Presbyterian Church, and an Elder at First Presbyterian Church. Dr. Percy was a junior department Sunday school teacher for 50 years. He was a veteran of WWII serving in the US Navy. Dr. Percy was a pediatrician for 42 years. He also worked at Social Security DDS for 15 years. He was a member of Jefferson County Pediatric Society and a former president. He served as a board member of the Presbyterian Home for Children in Talladega, AL. Dr. Percy graduated from the University of Alabama. He was preceded in death by his wives, Billie Gene Sullivan and Mary B. Sullivan; his brother, Jack Sullivan and his niece, Beth Sullivan. He is survived by his son, William B. Sullivan. Funeral service will be Thursday, October 20, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. at the old First Presbyterian Church in Bessemer with burial following at Cedar Hill Cemetery. Rev. Randy Kesler will be officiating.
