



William "Scott" Shepard

William "Scott" Shepard, of Montgomery, Alabama, died on Friday March 22, 2024 at the age of 84. Born in 1939, he was the son of the late William A. and Scottie Shepard of Bessemer, Alabama. He was a graduate of Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, and earned his Master's degree in Business Administration from the University of Alabama. He had a long career in retailing and real estate development, as Chief Financial Officer both for Pizitz department store as well as for the Florida panhandle master-planned community, Seaside. His real-estate developments included Blenheim Place, located in Birmingham. He was proud of his Scottish heritage and was an active member of the St. Andrew's Society of the Middle South, serving as president in 1984. He is survived by his daughter Shawn (John) of Concord, North Carolina, son Christopher (Mindy) of Trussville, Alabama, and multiple grandchildren.
